

Talon Series Owner's Manual



Congratulations on your purchase of an Osprey Talon Series pack. Our obsession with detail rewards you with a truly full-featured pack and we want to be sure that you understand and utilize your pack completely. Here's a full tour of your pack from the ground up.



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SHARED FEATURES

AirScape™ Backpanel

Every Talon Series pack features the AirScape™ backpanel, a mesh covered, 4MM HDPE ridge molded foam backpanel with integrated channels and central air chimney.



Torso Adjustable Harness

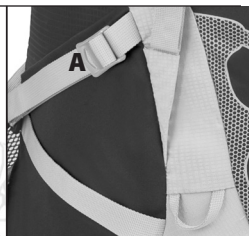


The Talon 44, 33 and 22 feature two torso adjustable sizes. To adjust, **A** loosen load lifter straps at top of harness, **B** slide hand between backpanel and harness to release hook and loop closure, **C** slide harness

into position using arrows to guide.

Front/Dual Side Stretch Woven Pockets

The Talon 44, 33 and 22 feature a stretch woven front pocket with integrated blinker patch and dual stretch woven side pockets with InsideOut™ Compression allowing you to tension and secure your load easily even when the pockets are in use. To route the



InsideOut™ compression straps as desired, **A** locate the duckbill to the top and side of the stretch woven side pocket and unthread the webbing through this buckle and the corresponding slider buckle near the back panel of the pack. **B** Now route the webbing for inner or outer compression by positioning the slider buckle inside or outside of the side pocket and reversing the process above.

HydraForm™ Reservoir

Add an Osprey HydraForm™ 2 or 3 liter hydration reservoir to your pack for stable, efficient, on-the-go water management. For more information, please visit your local Osprey retailer or visit www.ospreypacks.com.



Strap Retention

The harness/hipbelt straps feature strap keepers that secure excess webbing. The retention system features sewn-on C-clips which can be easily slotted over the hipbelt/harness webbing **A** to prevent strap flap.



Tow Loop

Every Talon pack (except the Talon 4/8 lumbars) features an integrated tow loop sewn in near the base of the pack.

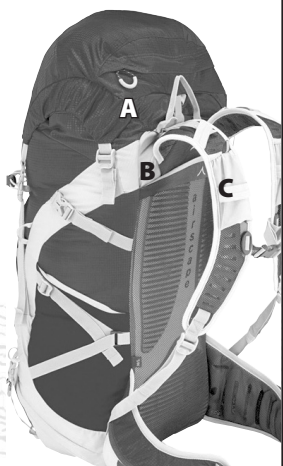


BioStretch™ Harness



Every harnessed Talon pack features the Talon BioStretch™ harness consisting of mesh-covered, slotted foam, dual stretch woven energy gel pockets and an adjustable sternum strap with rescue whistle buckle.

External Hydration Compartment



Located between the backpanel and main pack body is an exterior hydration compartment. (Talon 4 and 8 have bottle sleeves.) **A** Locate the H2O icon and loosen load lifter straps at the top of the pack. **B** Place the reservoir in the compartment using the sewn-in hanger to hold it upright. **C** Route the hose left/right through elastic routers on the harness as preferred, close compartment and re-tension load lifter straps.

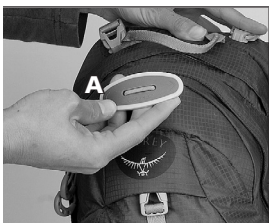
ErgoPull™ Hipbelt



The Talon Series uses our exclusive ErgoPull™ hipbelt closure design. (Talon 11, 5.5, 8 and 4 use a modified, single ErgoPull™ System.) To operate the ErgoPull™,

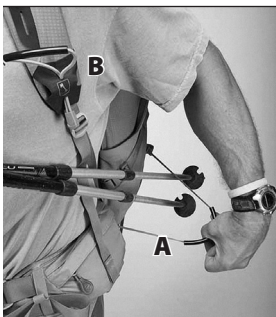
loosen the webbing enough so you can connect the center buckle. Then grasp the loose ends of the webbing on both side, and pull in and across evenly with both hands at the same time.

LidLock™ Helmet Clip (Talon 11, 22 only)



The Talon 22 and 11 feature a LidLock™ helmet clip with elasticized load control system providing quick and secure helmet carry. To use **A** Locate LidLock™ clip near the top of the pack's front panel and pull away from the pack. **B** In the vertical position, pass LidLock™ through helmet vent from the bottom and engage in horizontal position. On the right outside panel of the pack find a cord loop to increase or decrease tension. Reverse to remove helmet.

Stow On The Go™ Attachment System



(Talon 44, 33 only)

To operate: shorten trekking poles to a safe, manageable size, **A** locate the elasticized cord loop on the lower left side of pack and pull loop away from the side pocket, inserting the basket end of your poles. **B** On the left harness strap locate the trekking pole icon, **C** grasp the cord lock beneath the fabric patch and pull up on the cord to open the bungee loop. Place pole handles in the loop and tighten to secure. Reverse to remove.

Talon 44

The Talon 44 is a top loading technical backpack with a removable top pocket ideal for light backpacking, thru-hiking and trekking.

- 1** Removable zippered top pocket with internal stash pouch, key clip and under lid mesh map pocket
- 2** External closure/front pocket compression
- 3** Dual bungee tool tie-offs
- 4** Upper and lower side compression/carry straps
- 5** BioStretch™ mesh covered, perforated foam hipbelt with zippered side pockets
- 6** Dual ice tool loops
- 7** Sleeping pad straps
- 8** Zippered lower compartment access



- 9** Additional tie-off points
- 10** Stow on the Go™ Trekking Pole Attachment
- 11** Peripheral aluminum frame with aluminum head cup (internal)
- 12** Expandable collar with dual draw cord closure (internal)

Talon 33

The Talon 33 is a top loading technical backpack with a fixed top pocket ideal for light overnights, day long adventures and multi-day adventure races

- 1** Fixed zippered top pocket with internal stash pouch, key clip and under lid mesh map pocket
- 2** External closure/front pocket compression strap
- 3** Dual bungee tool tie-offs
- 4** Side compression/carry straps
- 5** BioStretch™ mesh covered, perforated foam hipbelt with zippered side pockets
- 6** Dual ice tool loops



- 7** Additional tie-off points
- 8** Stow on the Go™ Trekking Pole Attachment
- 9** Inside panel stash pocket (internal)

- 1 Top slash pocket with internal key clip
- 2 Dual zippered, main panel access
- 3 Front pocket compression strap
- 4 Side compression/carry straps
- 5 BioStretch™ mesh covered, perforated foam hipbelt with zippered side pockets
- 6 LidLock™ Helmet Clip

- 1 Dual zippered main panel access
- 2 Zippered slash pocket with internal key clip
- 3 Bungee laced front carry/compression system
- 4 Mesh hipbelt with zippered side pockets
- 5 Fixed harness with quick-clip load lifter/hydration access
- 6 Lidlock™ Helmet Clip

- 1 Dual zippered main panel access
- 2 Fixed harness with quick-clip load lifter/hydration access
- 3 Zippered front slash pocket with internal stash pocket and key clip
- 4 Stretch woven front pocket with internal bungee
- 5 Hip compression straps
- 6 Mesh hipbelt
- 7 Lidlock™ Helmet Clip

- 1 Dual zippered main compartment opening
- 2 Horizontal StraightJacket™ style compression with strap keepers
- 3 Foam reinforced bottle sleeves with bungee and side compression
- 4 BioStretch™ mesh covered slotted foam hipbelt with zippered fabric pockets
- 5 Zippered front slash pocket with internal key clip
- 6 Hip compression straps
- 7 Front bungee storage/compression system
- 8 Two Osprey Sports Bottles included
